PREREQUISITES COURSE LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

PRESCHOOL L 1-3

The primary objective of this course is to promote the developmentally appropriate learning of fundamental water safety and aquatic skills by young children about 4 and 5 years old. Some skill are; water entry/exit, breath control, buoyancy, treading and swimming on front and back.

LEVEL 1

No previous experience required. Recommended minimum age for entry is 6. Designed to help students feel comfortable in water, and enjoy the water safely. Instructors will teach elementary aquatics skills which students build on as they progress through the 6 learn-to-swim levels.

LEVEL 2

Must have L-1 certificate or be able to successfully demonstrate Exit Skills for L-1. Objective of Level 2 is to give student success with fundamental skills. Students learn to float unsupported and begin true locomotion skills with front crawl and back crawl, and basic rescue skills.

LEVEL 3

Must have L-2 certificate or be able to successfully demonstrate Exit Skills for L-2. Objective for Level 3 is to build on skills from L-2 with additional guided practice. Survival float, front crawl, elementary backstroke are taught. Dolphin and scissors kicks, and head first entries are introduced. Treading water is continued.

LEVEL 4

Must have L-3 certificate or successfully demonstrate Exit Skills for L-3. Objective for Level 4 is to develop confidence in the strokes learned so far and improve other aquatic skills. Endurance is increased, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly and turns are introduced.

LEVEL 5

Must have L-4 certificate or successfully demonstrate Exit Skills for L-4. Objective for Level 5 is to coordinate and refine all strokes and increase distances. Flip turns are introduced.

LEVEL 6

- A. Personal Water Safety
- B. Fitness Swimmer
- C. Fundamentals of Diving

Must have L-5 certificate or successfully demonstrate Exit Skills for L-5. Objective for Level 6 is to refine strokes so students swim with more ease, proficiency, power and smoothness over longer distances. Other aquatic activities are introduced to prepare students for more advanced courses. See A. B. C. under Level 6.
